<u>Algorithm</u> : A sequence of instructions to solve a problem, followed by a computer	<u>Anthropomorphism</u> : Giving human attributes to objects or animals
<u>AI detector</u> : A tool designed to detect when a text was AI-generated	<u>Artificial intelligence (AI)</u> : Intelligence demonstrated by machines
<u>AI writing</u> : Use of AI technology to produce or edit text (e.g., chatbots, paraphrasing tools)	<u>Automation</u> : Handling a process with machines or software so that less human input is needed
<u>Autonomous</u> : Able to perform tasks without human input	<u>Bard</u> : A chatbot developed by Google, released in March 2023
<u>Bing Chat</u> : A chatbot feature created by Microsoft, released in February 2023	<u>Chatbot</u> : A software application that mimics human conversation, usually through text
<u>CAPTCHA</u> : A test used online to ensure that the user is human	<u>Deepfake</u> : AI-generated images and videos designed to look real
<u>ChatGPT</u> : A chatbot released by OpenAI in November 2022	<u>Machine learning</u> : When AI acquires knowledge from training data
<u>Deep learning</u> : A form of machine learning based on AI	<u>Neural network</u> : Computer systems designed to mimic human brain
<u>Large language model</u> : A system trained on large amounts of text to imitate human language	<u>Robot</u> : Machine capable of carrying out physical actions automatically
<u>Machine translation</u> : Use of software to translate text between languages	<u>Training data</u> : The dataset that was used to train an AI system
<u>Natural language processing (NLP)</u> : The study of interaction between computers and human language	<u>Turing test</u> : A test of a machine's ability to display human intelligence
<u>OpenAI</u> : A leading AI company that developed ChatGPT and DALL-E	<u>Programming</u> : The process of giving instructions to a computer (using computer code)
<u>Paraphrasing tool</u> : An AI writing tool that automatically rephrases the text you type into it	<u>Plagiarism</u> : Not allowed use of the words or ideas of others
